PROJECT OVERVIEW

RES is proposing to develop the Kerrs Creek Wind Farm.

The Project will support the current strategic direction of the NSW and Australian energy generation market in developing high quality renewable energy to meet Australia's growing needs.

The Kerrs Creek Wind Farm Project will involve the development, construction and operation of the wind farm, including associated connection infrastructure to the existing 330kV transmission line that runs between Mt Piper and Wellington.

RES is continuing the development of the Project. Planning and independent environmental assessments are ongoing

and will give shape to the Project development in parallel with community feedback.

PROJECT LOCATION

The site is located approximately 21km north of Orange within the Dubbo Local Government Area in NSW.

The Project is located between Kerrs Creek and Euchareena along Burrendong Way.

The Project is proposed on privately owned land currently used for grazing, where ecological impact is expected to be limited.

As development of the Project continues, community feedback and study results will help to shape the Project and changes to the layout are expected.

Project design update

Since release of the scoping report design in late 2023, RES has been listening to the community and working to address the feedback we have heard.

Key changes include:

- a reduction in the overall project size from 63 to 55 wind turbines
- a reduction in the maximum proposed height of wind turbines from 280m to 253.5m
- revision of the project layout to help reduce impacts on both ecological values and neighbouring properties
- revision of project traffic impacts along Burrendong Way.

Development application update

RES anticipates the development application for the proposed Kerrs Creek Wind Farm will be lodged in Q4 2024.
